e-Portfolio Framework Page Assignment #2 Goals Page

What is a goal? A goal is something you intend to do, and/or something you want to achieve.

In this assignment you will develop a My Goals Page. In this section, you have an opportunity to tell people where you want to go – both in terms of academics and in your life outside of school.

Your Goals page should have three sections. As with your Welcome/About Me page, you should only include information that you are willing to have others see. Please also keep in mind that this is an academic site, and your goals should primarily reflect your interests and aspirations as they connect to your educational experience.

- 1. <u>Academic goals</u> Do you have a major? What kind of degree do you hope to earn? Do you want to transfer? Do you know where?
- 2. Career goals Do you have one? If not, don't worry there's lots of time to figure things out. You might want to just list some possible interests
- 3. <u>Life goals</u> what kind of person are you? What do you hope to accomplish in life?

When developing goals for these categories, try to identify both short term and long term goals for each category.

When done well, goals are SMART:

- Specific
- Measurable (what measurement will you use to know you achieved your goal?)
- Action-Oriented (specify what action you will take)
- Realistic (don't become frustrated or lose momentum)
- Time Delineated(ie. have a deadline)

Your My Goals section is meant to evolve – it might change over the course of the semester, or the year, or over several semesters. Like the rest of your e-Portfolio, it is a living document that changes as you do.

The Goals page will be evaluated as part of the overall evaluation of your ePortfolio, based on the Evaluation Template/Rubric that can be found in the ePortfolio module of your Blackboard site.
