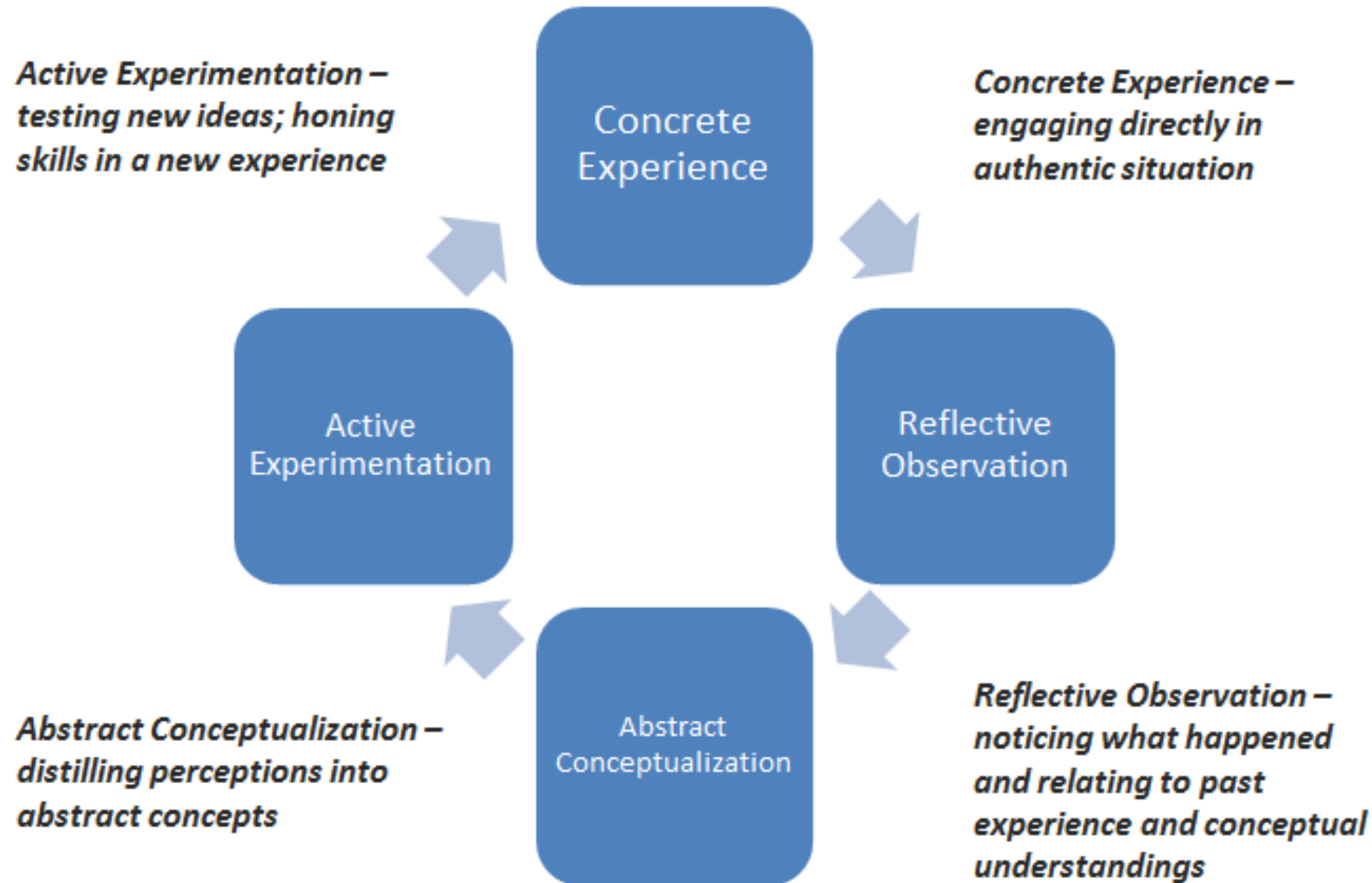
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WHAT IS EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING?

ELEMENTS OF EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

- EXPERIENCES ARE CAREFULLY CHOSEN FOR LEARNING POTENTIAL
- LEARNER IS ACTIVELY ENGAGED
- REFLECTION TAKES PLACE FOLLOWING THE EXPERIENCE
- LEARNING TASK IS AUTHENTIC
- RELATIONSHIPS ARE DEVELOPED AND NURTURED
