- 2. Accessibility: <u>Creating accessible content and adding alternative text to images is straightforward</u>, and the intuitive navigation removes the need for interface-specific directional prompts.
- 3. Future Ready: Live courses for a given semester must be converted to Ultra before adding any content AND before students have access to that semester's courses. Reference the <u>Key Dates for Winter and Spring 2025</u> and <u>Instructions to enable Ultra</u> guides.
- 4. Three Levels Deep: Keep the three-level limit for nested content in mind when designing a new course or reusing content from Original. Learn more about nested content and copying from Original.
- 5. Smooth Copy Process: When reusing existing content, start the copy process from the destination course. Check out our step-by-step guide to copying content. Some content types do not convert from Original.
- Centralized Messages: All Messages are sent from within Blackboard Ultra to ensure a centralized record of communication. The option to send a copy of messages to MC email is also available. <u>Learn</u> <u>more about Messages</u>.
- Customizable Gradebook: The Gradebook and Overall Grade column can be easily customized to fit
 your grading schema. Rubrics can also be added at the assignment or test level. Learn more about

- 8. **Schedule Announcements:** Draft Announcements and Schedule Send in advance to simplify communication with your students. Announcements can also be copied to MC email. **Learn more about scheduling Announcements**.
