Growth in Z Courses and OER Initiatives: Expanding Access and Affordability

Montgomery College is proud to be a national leader in increasing access and affordability through its MC Open initiatives. These efforts eliminate textbook costs for students, providing them with high-quality freely available open educational resources (OER) that foster an inclusive, welcoming, and accessible learning environment.

The College has seen remarkable progress in Z course offerings over the last few semesters. Since MC Open was officially launched in Spring 2017, student enrollment in Z courses has grown significantly. By Fall 2024, this enrollment reached record numbers, with more than 12,500 student enrollments in Z courses over the last three semesters. The number of Z course sections has expanded alongside enrollment, reflecting strong faculty adoption and commitment to accessible education. This growth supports a wide array of disciplines, allowing students to find Z course options in diverse fields. During this Fall 2024, 328 unique instructors are now engaged in offering Z courses in 634 sections at the College. In addition, the College has five Zdegrees and one Z-certificate. These collective efforts underscore a robust commitment to providing high-quality, no-cost OER, tailoring content to meet the diverse needs of our students.

This ongoing expansion of Z courses and OER at Montgomery College demonstrates our dedication to reducing financial barriers and promoting quality in higher education. Through the concerted efforts of our faculty and the support of the College community, we are empowering students to pursue their academic goals with fewer economic challenges and an increased sense of belonging.

Quality Assurance Reviewer Badge -

This badge validates that the earner has demonstrated the competencies necessary for inclusive quality course review in a virtual (online or remote) learning environment. Prerequisites: Successful completion of Training: QA Design & Delivery, QA Transformer Badge, or MC Online Teaching; and Experience: Quality



Matters Peer Reviewer, or equivalent reviewer designation, or at

least (three) years experience in relevant Education Technology for online learning.

These are just a few of the 39 badges available for students and employees to earn. With over 685 badges issued already—80% of them earned by students—there's no better time to explore these opportunities.
